

Petition in relation to protecting Margaret River's Mowen Forest from logging

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to the Forest Products Commission's plans to log 1,610 hectares of Margaret River's Mowen Forest because the logging of jarrah and marri trees will affect threatened fauna such as the Forest Red-Tailed Black Cockatoo, Baudin's Cockatoo, Brush-tailed Phascogale, Orange-Bellied Frog and Quokka. Logging is also a dieback and salinity risk to the area and would have detrimental social and financial impacts.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully ask the Legislative Council to support the protection of Mowen Forest from all logging operations in 2014 and in the future.
